Group Registration

Group registration is done through parish youth groups, The deadline is **May 24, 2019**. As a Youth Minister or Parish Group Leader bringing youth to the Youth Track of the Eucharistic Congress, you must complete the following steps

1. Find your adult chaperons/volunteers
 - a. Minimum two adults for the first eight youth
 - b. Additional one for each additional eight
 - c. Adult chaperon requirements
 - i. Adult chaperones must be cleared. All adult volunteers must register as a volunteer. Adults should register for the Youth Track and put in the comments which parish they are coming with.

2. Each youth must have a Parental Consent and Emergency Medical Release Form filled out and signed.
3. Youth Ministers/Group Leaders must bring all completed forms(one for each youth) to the Youth Track
4. Youth Ministers/Group Leaders will need to register the number of middle and high school youth attending. Adult chaperones will need to register individually, noting the parish group.
5. Register your group at the Volunteer Registration.

Individual Registration

The Youth Track of the Eucharistic Congress is designed for parish groups. We encourage that you ask your pastor or youth minister if a group from your parish plans on attending. For individuals who do not have a parish youth group participating, parents may register their child. The deadline is **June 23, 2019**. Parents must fill out the Parental Consent Emergency Medical Release Form and provide it during check-in at Teen Track. Without the completed form, youth cannot participate in the Youth Track.

Other Questions?

My child is registered to attend with his/her parish group; may he/she bring a younger sibling?

No, the Youth Track is for Parish groups of youth who are rising 7th-12th graders.

Is there a cost to attend?

This event is free, Parish groups must register in advance

Is transportation to the Eucharistic Congress included?

No, each parish group that is registered arranges their own transportation to and from the Congress.

Where is Youth Track?

The Youth Track is a part of the 2019 Birmingham Eucharistic Congress. The Congress will be held at the BJCC, 1001 19th St N, Birmingham, AL 35203.

When does the Youth Track begin and end?

The Youth Track begins at 9:30 and lasts until 3:00 on June 29, 2019.

Will our Parish Group attend the closing Mass?

This is a question for your parish group leader, some groups may plan to stay, where other may not.
